The church and landscape appear similar to that of Kempsey which is located south of Worcester. Leader painted a number of views at Kempsey during the course of his life. Benjamin Williams Leader was born Benjamin Leader Williams on 12 March, 1831 in Worcester. His father was Edward Leader Williams, a civil engineer and keen amateur artist and his mother was Sarah Whiting. He was educated at the Royal Grammar School in Worcester and initially followed in his father's footsteps to become an engineer. During the day he w...
