Agrippina Minor was the Empress of Rome at one point. This is a later recasting from the original - circa 1810. Such a great piece of classical art, look how the artist has rendered the folds to her toga. She sits gracefully on an ornate chair with curved legs and a backrest that has a brass finish.
