Description

A scholarly Longquan celadon of broad profile with lobed rim and carved chrysanthemum within a scrolling cavetto. The translucent sea-green glaze pools in carved recesses and whitens delicately at the rim. The exterior has evenly spaced vertical "melon" fluting; the foot is high, cleanly cut, and shows kiln grit with a central glaze button. Attributes confirm a mature Southern Song to early Yuan example: fine compact body, high-lime glaze with micro-bubbles, and hand-carved drawing under the glaze. UV-checked: rim and base inert, no restoration. Measurements Diameter: 20.6 cm (8.1") Rim thickness: ~6.1–6.2 mm Footring height: ~9.5 mm Weight: approx. 560 g Condition Excellent, structurally intact. No restoration, chips, or cracks; only kiln grit and minor firing freckles typical of period Longquan ware.
