A grand glazed earthenware ewer of impressive 50 cm height, combining relief modelling with naturalistic painting. The lid is formed as a boar's head, the handle as a ram's head, and the spout as a satyr mascon. Between the gilt vine friezes, a marsh-bird panel demonstrates refined hand-painting typical of Choisy-le-Roi or Sarreguemines around 1880–1890.
