It is approximately 31" (79cm) high and it is 25" (64cm) wide across the arms. The seat is approximately 18" (46cm) deep and 17 1/4" (44cm) high. It is in good condition for its age. It has developed a nice aged patina and is a strong and sturdy chair. The chair is not without a few small marks and signs of age and use but no major damages and nothing detrimental.
