Description

An early eighteenth century oak low dresser c1720 - 1730, with three drawers and two doors either side of a central panel, the full width cupboard providing plenty of storage space. The dresser has a fabulous colour and patina, and combined with its pleasing proportions, presents beautifully. This dresser was sourced from a local property and has been in the family for as long as the seller can remember. It is a substantial and heavy piece of furniture that has real presence - it looked fantastic standing in the flagstoned hallway of their 17th century home. The drawers have ovolo moulded edges, and the central drawer and right hand drawer have locks (though no key). The doors have raised and fielded panels, with the same detail replicated on the central panels and end panels. The doors are hung on H hinges - neither pair are original but the ones on the left door are significantly older than those on the right. The locks on the doors are replacements and don't work, but we have found an old iron key that fits into the escutcheon to use as a handle. The drawer handles are not original but suit the piece well, and you can just see the outline of where oval plate handles ...
