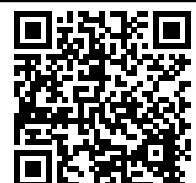

It is top marked (hallmarks at the top reverse of the handle) and although the Maker's mark is absent, it bears the same crest and date as the Paul Storr gravy ladle, listed beside it - suggesting that it is made by the great maker.
