They normally come with fitted sliding trays in the interior of the top section designed to allow easy access to the folded linen, however these have often now been removed & replaced with a hanging rail to allow storage of clothes on hangers which is more in keeping with modern day living. This particular linen press is a great size, constructed from superb quality, rich and well figured mahogany and boasts elegant oval panels to its doors.
