At the centre, a bijin is depicted among children in a tranquil garden beneath a camellia tree, executed in polychrome enamels and gold. The interior features a gilt floral border, while the exterior bears a frieze of irises in soft translucent tones. The removed mark on the base is typical of Kyoto resale pieces.
