Condition: There is an old stable split in the top, and one of the legs has had some filler applied where it comes through the top - I think the peg joint has probably been damaged and repaired. Otherwise very good condition and very solid with a lovely colour and patina. Dimensions: Width - 49cm Depth - 34cm Height - 55.5cm The seat measures 39.5cm wide by 22cm deep.
