They are both well painted and signed in the lower left corners. Both are framed in their original good quality gilt frames with gilt slips. The paintings are in good order however there are some minor surface marks and blemishes but they display well. There are a few small knocks and losses and some wear around the frames but nothing detrimental. Edward King Redmore was born in Hull. He was the son of noted British marine painter Henry Redmore (1820-1887) who exhibited at the Royal Academy. Edward took up his famous father's profession and spent his life painting marine scenes in and around Hull.
