Description

C18th George III Chippendale period mahogany chest of drawers of small scale and proportions. Fitted with 2 short over 3 long 'cock-beaded' and oak-lined graduated drawers, all retaining their original sophisticated cast brass rococo design handles, with brass escutcheons and steel locks (no key). The whole raised on original shaped bracket feet, rectangular top with a moulded edge. The underside having laminated blocks behind the mahogany bracket feet and a red-wash finish, in the manner of the Chippendale workshops. The verso fitted with original red-washed back-boards. In excellent original condition having achieved a rich colour and patina to the original polished surface. The top with minor historic marks commensurate with age, use and purpose. A smart Georgian mahogany chest-of-drawers of desirable compact scale and proportions. Has an interesting receipt with it from Gordon & Mellor of Toxteth, Liverpool dated 16th July 1889 to a Mr Roberts for a "Mahogany Chest of Drawers £4.0.0 " H 32" W 36" D 19" England c.1760
