Presented To Mr Norman Hardy In Recognition of Taking 8 Wickets for 16 Runs Including The Hat Trick At Exmouth July 14th. An unusual antique mounted cricket ball trophy that would be an excellent addition to a collection of cricket memorabilia. Hallmarks: Hallmarked to band on the ball and also stand with Lion for Sterling Silver. Leopard's head for London. Date letter g for 1922. Maker's mark DF for Josiah Williams & Co. Dimensions: Width: 8.5 cm (3 1/4"). Depth (including ball): 7 cm (2 3/4"). Height (including ball): 11.5 cm (4 1/2"). Weight: 240 g total.
