Resting atop a richly textured base reminiscent of coral and sea life, the warmer features a hinged lid and an interior chamber where hot water would be poured to maintain warmth. With its ocean-inspired form and shimmering finish, this is both a functional antique and a decorative objet d'art – circa 1880. * Spoon warmers were elite dining accessories in the Victorian era - now rare and collectible.
