You are viewing a lovely bronze casting of a bronze buddha, a finely crafted seated bronze figure of Guanyin (Kwan Yin), the Bodhisattva of Compassion in East Asian Buddhism Circa 1930 and with lovely patina to the bronze Guanyin is seated in the lotus position (padmasana) upon a double-lotus pedestal base.
