Large Japanese charger decorated in the traditional Imari palette of dark 'inky' and pale blue hues, iron-reds and gilded highlights. Painted with floral designs with mythical beasts to the edges. The central circular medallion with fanned segmented design, surrounded with divided panels of further decoration. The verso decorated to the edges with floral vignettes, having triple blue ring around the raised foot-rim and a further double blue ring within. The interior of the foot-rim having kiln spur-marks to the glaze produced when fired. A highly decorative early Edo period charger in excellent original condition with no damage or repairs.
