A well-modelled Georgian Irish silver sauceboat raised on three paw feet with shell-moulded terminals, the body richly chased with birds among flowering scrolls. The beaded rim and leaf-capped scroll handle are typical of Dublin work of the period. The vacant reserve was long ago professionally filled, leaving a smooth panel that sits neatly within the original chased frame — a feature commonly seen on presentation pieces. The underside shows radiating flutes with dotted beading and clear maker's mark for Ambrose Boxwell, together with incomplete hallmarks including the initials IW. ?
