Square in form with slice cut polished edges, it has the words engraved and then enamelled in white and blue "PIGEON BLEND SPECIAL SUPPLIED BY Samuel Dow Ltd GLASGOW". Polished base. **Comments** Samuel Dow Limited was established in 1807 and the company was known for its range of blended scotch whiskies and its Public Houses around the city of Glasgow. Whisky blends included Samuel Dow's specially selected blended scotch whisky and Dow's Pigeon Blend. This is an exceptionally rare piece of Scottish Glasgow advertising which we are confident won't be found elsewhere. **Date & Origin** Scotland, c1870. Period of Victoria. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. A tiny pinprick on the pouring rim, a few internal stains which can be cleaned. The enamel is in excellent condition.
