One has (E) Ronadson dated 1877 on back the other has Monogram M.R (possibly) dated 1879 both seem to be by the same hand but are difficult to decipher. Both framed and mounted in attractive faux bamboo frames. Size in frames 46 x 35 cm, image size 30 x 21 cm Lakeside Castle / Ruins Scene picture: Shows a castle or ruined fortification on a hillside beside a lake or broad river.
