The cylindrical body is beautifully understated, with two matching bands of reeded decoration and is free from initials or any other engraving. The pull off domed lid opens to reveal the internal reservoir for the nutmeg. To the base is a pull off cover for the original steel grater. With this removed the grater can be accessed and a full and clear set of hallmarks can be found on the inside base cover. A wonderful, rare and collectable piece. Dimensions below.
