A description of silversmith J & R Griffin was a British silversmith company founded in 1895 in Birmingham by brothers Joseph and Richard Griffin, which ceased trading in 1926. They produced a wide range of silverware, including personal, domestic, and table items, and are known for their pieces hallmarked in Chester, which was common for many Birmingham-based silversmiths at the time. History: Founded in 1895, the firm was incorporated as a private limited company in 1902 and employed 240 people by 1914. Products: They made various silverware, including napkin rings, scent bottles, and vesta cases. Assay Office: While based in Birmingham, much of their work was sent to the Chester Assay Office...
