An interesting early example of neat proportions. 2 feet 5" high x 2 feet 4" wide x 16 1/2 inches deep, (closed). The square section trefoil pad feet are unusual, likely Scottish or Irish. Condition: Structurally solid, with a few minor repairs undertaken over the past 300 or so years. There are a couple of small historic veneer replacements to the sides of the frieze and sections of walnut repalced around both hinges.
