Biography: William Edward Webb (1862 - 1903) William Edward Webb was born in Cheltenham, Gloucestershire in 1862 and lived and worked most of his life in Manchester. He travelled throughout the United Kingdom painting coastal and marine scenes around significant ports and harbours. He spent considerable time in the Isle of Man painting numerous scenes, particularly of Peel and Douglas Harbours. He was also known to have painted scenes in Jersey and Guernsey in the Channel Islands. His style is described as highly distinctive - loose and informal yet retaining a sense of perspective and great detail. Personally, he struggled with ill health ...
