Each piece shows the clear hallmarks for the London Assay Office with a date mark for 1897 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. There is also the retailers mark George Maurice & Co 44 Piccadilly W. The maker's marks are for the silversmith W & G Neal. A collector's item, due to the rarity of this piece and the fine condition.
