The figure is shown kneeling in prayer with hands clasped, wearing flowing robes with beautifully carved folds and a well-defined bearded face full of character. This would originally have formed part of an altar or devotional group, placed opposite a matching donor or beneath a sacred scene. At 71 cm high, it is an impressive and substantial carving with real presence. The surface shows an attractive, centuries-old patina. Structurally sound and displaying very well.
