A sculptural early Coalport pot with cover, richly decorated in the Coalbrookdale style. Painted botanical panels—roses, anemones and other garden flowers—are combined with hand-modelled applied blooms, giving the piece its distinctive three-dimensional surface. The entwined handles, domed lid and floral finial form a balanced Regency silhouette. The underglaze cobalt "C Dale" mark is an early Coalbrookdale abbreviation recorded only on a small group of ornamental pieces. Measurements Height: 17.5 cm (6.89?) Width: 20 cm (7.87?) Depth: 14.5 cm (5.71?) Weight: 819 g Condition Scattered small losses to the applied flowers, consistent with age. Enamel colours are bright, and the gilding—especially on the handles—remains unusually intact. No structural issues. Shipping & Packaging Fully tracked and insured delivery.
