When I must stand before my judge. And pass the solemn test. Though lovely chief of all my joys. Thou sovereign of my heart. Now could I bear to hear thy voice pronounce the sound, ""Depart.", within a strawberry vine border. This is in excellent condition overall for its age with no wear or losses. It is in its original simulated rosewood frame which is in good order with one or two marks here and there commensurate with its age. The piece measures 68 cms by 70 cms overall including the frame.
