The everted rim is painted in underglaze blue, while the central roundel displays butterflies, floral motifs and scrolling foliage in richly coloured enamels. A fine example of Meiji-period craftsmanship. Historical Background Meiji artisans produced decorative wares of exceptional quality for export, often combining cloisonné enamelling with porcelain bodies to achieve vivid and detailed surfaces.
