A decorative pair of early 19th-century Derby porcelain candlesticks in the light rococo manner of the 1820s. Each piece stands on a broad scroll-moulded base with warm original gilding and carries a shaped candle cup decorated with hand-painted floral cartouches. The small roses and soft blue touches follow Derby's flower painting tradition linked to the Billingsley school.
