The quality of this beautiful oil painting on canvas, its detail, including the brush work, is almost certainly either that of John Frederick Herring senior, or possibly his son John Frederick Herring Junior, and certainly being one of his better works. The frame is of the rococo influence and compliments the painting well. JOHN FREDERICK HERRING, SR (BRITISH, 1795-1865). Artist John Frederick Herring, Sr., was an English painter born in 1795, who used oils on canvas. He was best known for his horse portraits, racehorses with riders up, hunting scenes, and family farm animals. John Frederick Herring's paintings were reproduced widely, including dozens of winners of the St. Leger Stakes and the Derby as engravings. Other reproductions of his work encompassed lithographs, aquatints, and even giclees. Many knew Arti...
