Below this is a triangle depicting health, sunshine and shopping, along with the words Luxury, Economy and Comfort. Engraved to the long elongated blade, 'Health', 'Sunshine' and 'Shopping' are repeated, along with the corresponding Hotels of Bath - Grand Pump Hotel, Brighton - Royal Crescent Hotel and London - Kensington W-De Vere Hotel.
