The canted corners dressed with interlaced acanthus drops. The base supported by turned spiral fluted tapering legs ending in acanthus sabots. The carcass of oak construction. Fine original gilding, key and condition throughout. Mounts incised 'FL'. Clement Linke Lock. Linke was born in Pankraz in Bohemia and was celebrated by the French as one of the greatest ébénistes of meubles de style at the turn of the century. He began his apprenticeship with a Bohemian master at the age of thirteen. Four years later, he toured Austria, settling and working in Vienna for two years. Linke arrived in Paris in 1875, and by 1881 he had established his own small workshop at 170 rue du Faubourg...

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
