The plate is in excellent, original condition, free from chips, cracks, restoration, or significant wear. Designs were inspired by Samuel Howitt's coloured engravings from Captain Thomas Williamson's Oriental Field Sports, Wild Sports of the East (1807). • • Scenes: The series includes a variety of titled hunting scenes such as "The Hog Deer at Bay," "Hunting a Hog Deer," and "Death of the Bear." Titles were typically printed on the reverse. • • About this Scene: "The Hog Deer at Bay" depicts the dramatic moment a hog deer is cornered by hunting dogs, corresponding to plate 40 of Williamson...

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
