The engraved gong face bears a stunning arrangement of five feather plumes tied with a ribbon - possibly an allusion to nobility or family crests. Marked 'JGS' for renowned maker George Jones and Sons. * Whether used as a summoning bell, a unique dinner gong, or simply as a statement piece, this gong captures the drama and flair of 19th-century decorative arts.
