Decorated in green, with a white and light blue pastel floral pattern on a gold background and a deep blue interior. "The distinctive feature of 'Chine Ware' is a textured netted background surface obtained by pressing moistened pieces of old point lace linen and other fabrics into the soft clay soon after the pots had come to the wheel."
