The box has a hinged lid and is adorned with finely engine-turned decoration and delicate hand-engraved foliate scrollwork, centering around a round cartouche featuring a traditional motif of a knight's arm holding a dagger – circa 1880. * Once a staple of the Victorian tea table, this elegant box was designed to store and present biscuits in genteel households - but its understated beauty now makes it equally suitable as a decorative box, jewellery holder, or collectible display piece.
