Made and sold by 'JW Carey, The Strand, London' dated January 1st 1816. The terrestrial globe's cartouche is inscribed 'Carey's new terrestrial globe, from the best authorities, made in London by G & J Carey, 86 St James Street, January 4th 1844'. Both resting on later mahogany stands with umbrella-style tripod bases. 124cm High, 30.5cm (12 inches)
