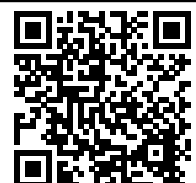

Tankerness House is now the home of Orkney Museum. This goblet has the family crest and a crisp set of hallmarks underneath. It is in excellent condition with no damage or repairs.
