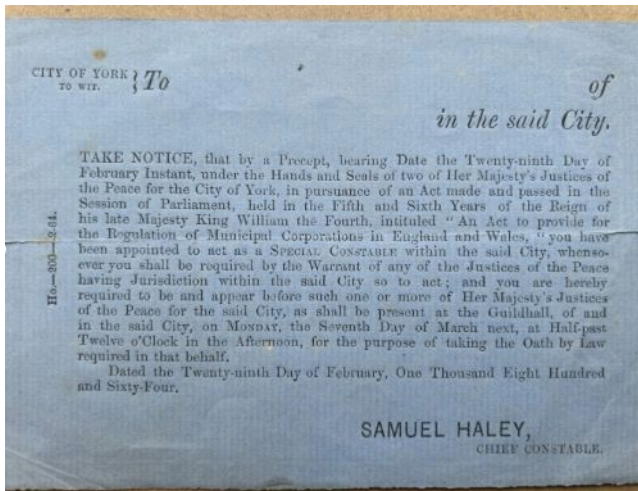

Type of item: Original Victorian Police / Local History Document – York Special Constable Appointment Surface: Printed on blue laid paper with visible watermark Issuer and Signature: Signed in print by Samuel Haley, Chief Constable of York Subject: An original City of York notice, dated 29th February 1864, appointing the named recipient as a Special Constable under the Municipal Corporations Act. The document requires the bearer to appear before the Justices of the Peace at York Guildhall to take the Oath of Service. A scarce survival of Victorian policing and civic administration, linked to Chief Constable Samuel Haley. Approximate age of item: Dated 1864 Is the item Framed or Mounted: Loose (unframed) Condition Report: In good overall condition for age. Central fold with small split and minor handling wear, but text remains strong and legible. Blue paper well preserved, with watermark visible when held to the light.
