An exceptional, fine and impressive, antique Victorian English sterling silver presentation cup; an addition to our Victorian silverware collection. This exceptional antique Victorian sterling silver cup has a bell-shaped form to a circular spreading foot. The tapering body of this solid silver presentation cup is embellished with exceptional chased neoclassical bands and floral garlands, incorporating four foliate bordered cartouches; three cartouches remain vacant. The cartouche to the anterior portion bears the contemporary engraved inscription 'Northumberland Agricultural Society, Alnwick Show 1875, Awarded by His Grace the Duke of Northumberland for the best Hunter to Mr Jacob W. Annett, Ulgham, Morpeth for 'The Arrow'; this presentation inscription could be professionally removed upon request. The upper rim of this Victorian trophy cup is encompassed with a chased tied festoon decorated border, accented with impressive figural mask designs to the anterior and posterior surfaces. This impressive Victorian cup is fitted with an exceptional pair of cast sterling silver scrolling handles, ornamented to the upper portion with a griffin design, with the displayed wi...
