With an ebonised top and brass detailing on the base. The credenza has 4 glazed panelled doors, showcasing the golden patterned interior and brass inlaid shelves. Boulle Boulle work (also known as buhl work) is a type of rich marquetry process or inlay perfected by the French cabinetmaker André-Charles Boulle (1642-1732). It involves veneering furniture with tortoiseshell inlaid primarily with brass and pewter in elaborate designs, often incorporating arabesques.
