A seconds dial, date aperture and lunar moon phases showing high water at Bristol quay (KEY). Signed to the dial "Thos Wynn, Bristol". An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Thomas Wynn of Bristol is recorded in A J Moores "The Clockmakers of Bristol" book as working from 1763. He was married in 1763 in Almondsbury (North Bristol). Condition: Superb original condition with nicely toned patina (untouched). Ticks and strikes with pressure on the great wheels. Supplied with matching pair of clock-face brass globes. [No cabinet].
