The raised gallery border is detailed with gadrooned edging and elegant shell motifs, while the integrated pierced handles are gracefully shaped for comfort and visual balance. The design reflects the refinement of early 20th-century British silverware, likely intended for formal dining or high-society entertaining – circa 1905.
