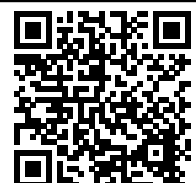
Fine pair of early 19th century yew Windsor arm chairs - probably of Nottinghamshire origin and of fine colour and patina; the backs with 'Christmas Tree' two-part splats and on turned legs with bowed stretchers.
