Early Life and Education • He was born on 27 December 1882 in Paris (18th arrondissement). • Lachaud earned a bachelor's degree in literature and attended the Lycée Condorcet in Paris. • He studied painting and graphic arts at the École nationale des Beaux-arts and later at the Académie Julian. ?? Artistic Beginnings • In 1908, while still a student, he discovered Brittany during family stays in Pont-Aven, a town famous for its artist colony. • His early career was interrupted by World War I, during which he served in the French Air Force and later as an instructor attached to the American Army. ??? Career and Artistic Work • After being demobilized in 1919, Lachaud settled in Névez near Pont-Aven until...
