The background dye is an sandy biscuit tone and full of various blue shades. The central looking through a window design is delightful and the detail in the border and water scenes are very beautiful. Pao Tao carpets are hand-knotted rugs from China with a long history. The tradition of hand-knotted rugs in China dates back thousands of years. The first written references to Chinese carpets appear in the Tang Dynasty (618–907), and historian Pan Ku (A.D. 32–92) mentions their production as early as the first century A.D. Originally knotted for the imperial court and their feature motifs were from porcelain paintings, such as dragons, birds, and floral patterns.
