The top rail with silver plated carrying handle and silver bindings. A working lock with original key set to the side upright, which works a key release mechanism for the fall front locking bar, which forms part of the tantalus base. The base with silver plated bound corners and cartouche. The original hobnail cut crystal decanters with matching stoppers in mint condition. The casework with a rich colour and original patina, presented in superb original condition. Measures 10.5" wide x 5.25" deep x 13" high.
