All decorated with beautifully carved floral and foliate swags with a central cherub on a criss-cross ground. It stands on ormolu tapering spiral cone feet and includes its original working locks and keys. The carcass stamped G.G and G. Grimard. Grimard was a prestigious French furniture maker operating at 5 Rue de Charonne, Paris, in the late 19th century. It is known for high-quality, often Louis XVI-style pieces. The firm produced ornate furniture, such as commodes, cabinets, and armoires, that frequently featured gilt-bronze mounts and marble tops. The company exhibited its work at major international exhibitions of the period.
