Description

An attractive antique Old Paris porcelain tea service comprising four pieces: teapot, covered sugar bowl, milk jug and bonbon dish. Made during the Louis-Philippe I period, the service shows the revival of rocaille-inspired forms typical of Paris porcelain in the 1840s. Decorated with a turquoise ground and floral panels associated with the Jacob Petit circle, the service is enhanced by fine gilding and light ornamental scrollwork. The decoration is balanced and well proportioned across all pieces. All four pieces belong to the same matching set and form a coherent decorative ensemble. A small underglaze pseudo-Sèvres stroke is present on the bases, used by Paris workshops as a quality indicator.
