The shaped oval top has a glass insert over a serpentine glazed cupboard door which opens to a fitted interior with a single glazed shelf. The cabinet is freestanding, the sides are all glazed and it is raised on elegant tapering cabriole legs decorated with foliate ormolu cast mounts on lion's paw feet. It bears the brass retailers label for the antique dealer S.Dawes & Son, of Chelsea, London, who would have retailed it in the past. Complete with working lock and key.
